#### Location

Just south of the Yellow River, Zhengzhou is the capital and largest city of Henan Province in central China and serves as the political, economic, technological, and educational center of the province. It is also known for scientific research. Zhenazhou is a major hub of China's transportation network and has an international airport. Is population is about 12 million and it is one of the 13 emerging mega-cities in China. Evidence of Shang dynasty settlements from around 1600 BC have been found in the area, but the name Zhengzhou was first used in 605 AD. It is situated on a vast fertile floodplain at the transitional zone between the North China Plain to the east and the Song and Xionger Mountains to the west.
